General Summary:	Good knowledge of the methods and practices used in installing, repairing and maintaining a variety of plumbing, gas and mechanical installations, equipment and appliances; good knowledge of possible defects and faults in plumbing, gas and mechanical systems and appliances and of effective corrective plumbing, gas and mechanical installations and appliances. Knowledge of municipal and state plumbing, mechanical and gas codes or an equivalent combination of training and experience required. Ability to diagnose defects and hazards in old and new installations; ability to enforce regulations with firmness, tact and impartiality; ability to establish and maintain effective relationships with contractors, property owners and the public at large. Ability to read and interpret new construction plans for approval. Ability to read and interpret all municipal plumbing, gas and mechanical codes.
Principal Duties and Responsibilities:	 Inspects the installation of drain pipes, soil pipes, waste or vent pipes, water pipes, gas pipes, sewer connections and water taps in the Muscogee Nation; and if the plumbing is connected to either the water system or the sewer system of the Nation, inspects the same outside City limits. Inspects the installation, repair or addition to any sanitary sewer, septic tank or sewage disposal system, water system, gas system, mechanical system, fixtures or appliances in new or existing system and investigates complaints concerning the working order of the above. Inspects excavations and required backfilling and may require additional backfilling for a period of one (1) year. Acts as a non-voting member and secretary of the Muscogee Nation Plumbing Hearing and Appeals Board. Issues or refuses the issuance of street cut permits, plumbing and mechanical permits and Front Footage Fee Applications. Reports and takes appropriate legal action, as necessary, on any violations concerning plumbing and mechanical in Nation ordinances. Issues Nation Plumbing and Mechanical Registrations when required. Inspects job sites to check for proper registrations and permits and that

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	work is in accordance with plans and codes.
	Reviews and approves new construction plans and blueprints to assure
	compliance with Nation codes and ordinances.
	Serves in other inspection capacities on an as-needed basis.
	Performs other work as necessary and or as assigned.

MCN Policy Requirements:

Medical Marijuana License Holder Protection and Non-Discrimination

A. Unless a failure to do would cause The Muscogee (Creek) Nation to imminently lose a monetary or licensing related benefit under federal law or regulations and with the exception of employees whose jobs are safety sensitive or primary job function is driving, The Muscogee (Creek) Nation shall not discriminate against a person in hiring, termination, or imposing any term or condition of employment or otherwise penalize a person based upon either: a. Solely, the person's status as a medical marijuana license holder; or b. Solely, the results of a drug test showing positive for marijuana and its components. B. Employees that are medical marijuana card holders shall not use, possess or be under the influence while at their place of employment or during hours of employment.

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
